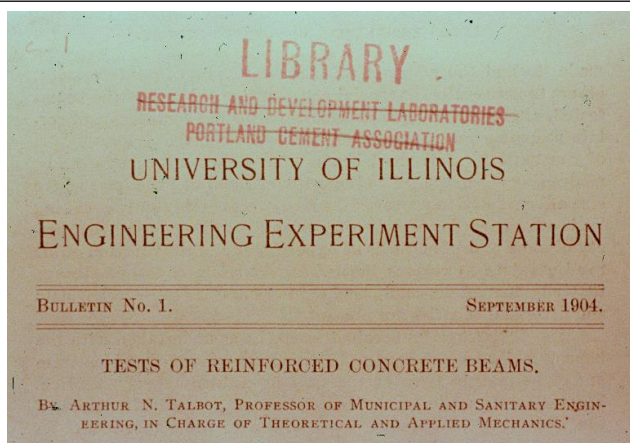
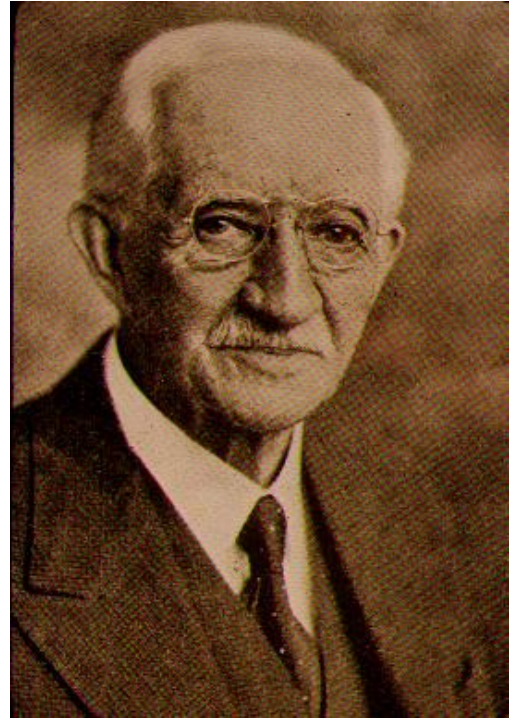


Prof. Arthur N. TALBOT



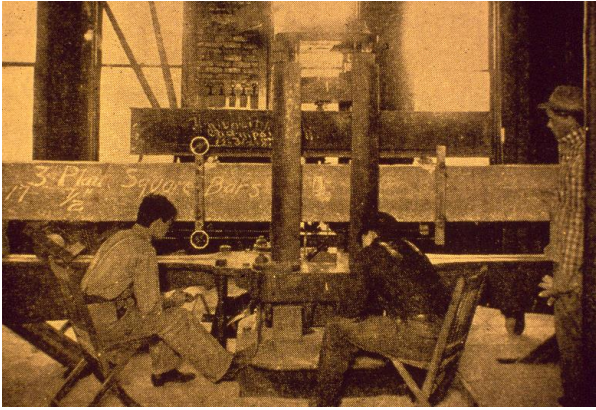

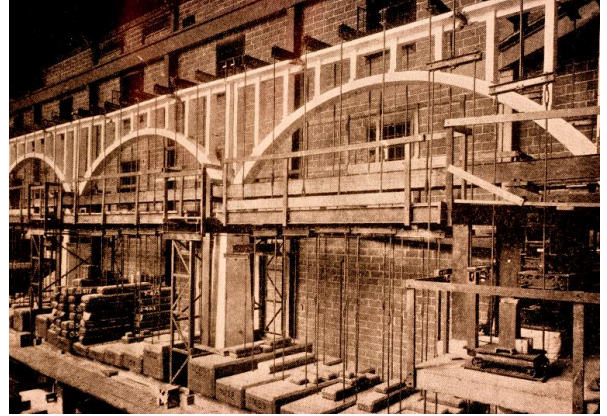
The new building: Materials Testing Laboratory, was named TALBOT Lab, where CE testing laboratory was located.



Below are examples of testing setups during Prof. TALBOT tenure and after he retired.



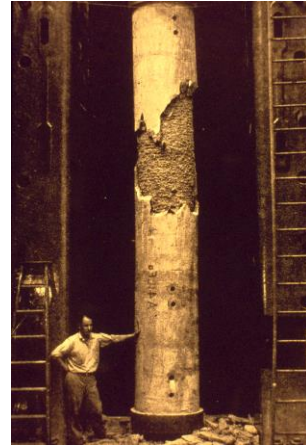
Beam Test in 1904
